Locate the CONCRETE/DELIVERY icon on your device, and click on it to start the application.



The login window will display, asking you to enter your login credentials.



ID	SECTION/COLONNE	DESCRIPTION
1	COMPANY	Type your company number in the Company section. This number is assigned to you by FOCUS and is unique to your organization.
2	USER	Type your username in the User section
3	PASSWORD	Type your password in the Password section

Then click "SING IN" to access the application.

SELECTING EQUIPMENT AND STARTING

Select your equipment from the list, or using the search field.



The "IN SERVICE" button indicates that the driver is ready to begin their workday.





Here is a detailed view of the main page:



ID	SECTION/COLONNE	DESCRIPTION
1	TRUCK NAME	Truck name, indicates the truck number
2	STATUS	The real-time status of the truck
3	# COMMAND	Number of the current order
4	# DELIVERY BILL	Number of the current ticket
5	M3 LOADED	M3 loaded—quantity of concrete loaded
6	PREVIOUS TRUCK	Previous truck
7	CLIENT NAME	Name of the client of the current order
8	DELIVERY ADDRESS	Delivery address of the current order

The driver can change their status using the pencil icon. In some particular situations, drivers may have to notify the system of their new status. For example, if the address of the destination is imprecise, the driver can indicate that he is on the construction site while the computer thinks he is 5km away.

The available statuses will be displayed in the drop-down menu. Select the status that corresponds to your current situation.










The "READY FOR THE NEXT DELIVERY" button indicates that the equipment is ready to be loaded to complete deliveries.







The purpose of the messaging page is to enable communication between drivers and dispatchers. The dispatcher must initiate a "conversation" so that a driver can reply. The replies are always from a selection of preestablished options.



Click on "SEND" to send a reply.

To logout, click on the exit button.
