From the main menu of the tablet, select the « OPTI-PATH » icon.



The connexion window will be displayed.



Enter the company number in the Company section **1**. This number is assigned to you by FOCUS and is specific to your organization.

Enter your user name in the User field **2**.

Enter your password in the password field **3**.

Then click on « SING IN » to access the application.

Refer to your organization's administrator for help with your login details.



Once you've logged in, you'll need to choose a piece of equipment from the list of available vehicles.

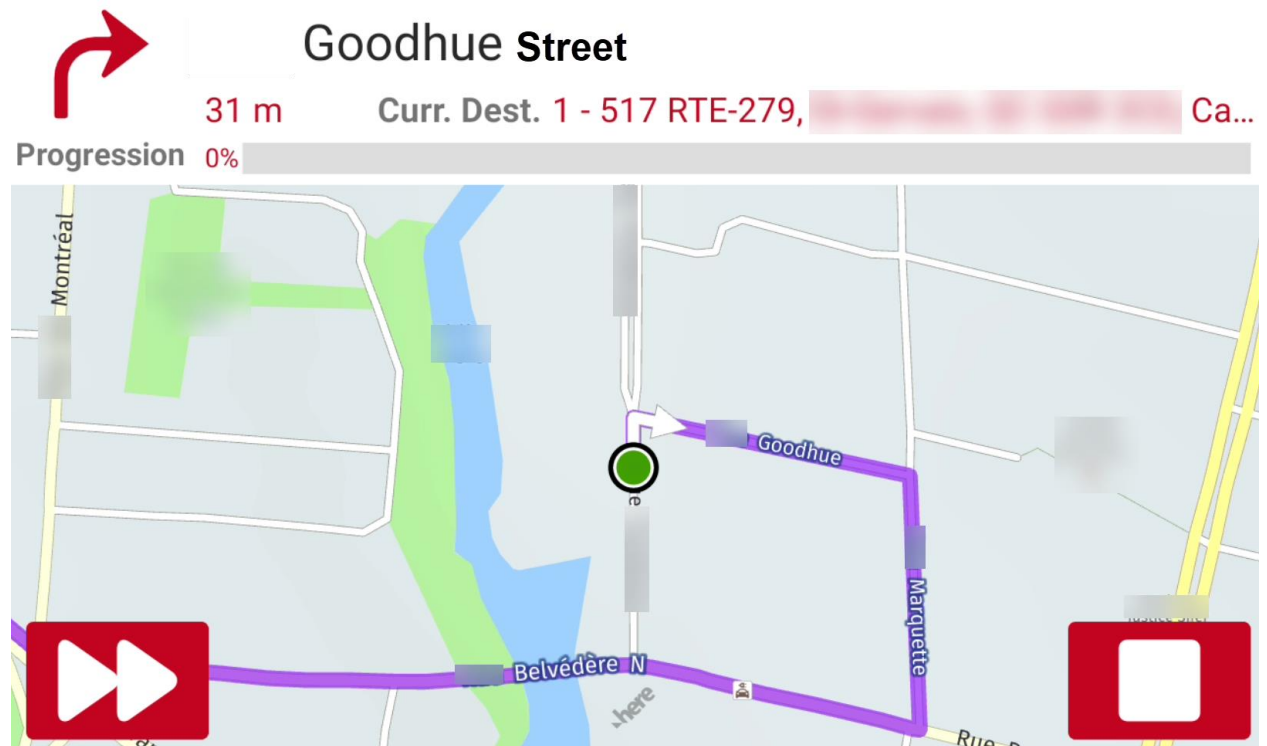
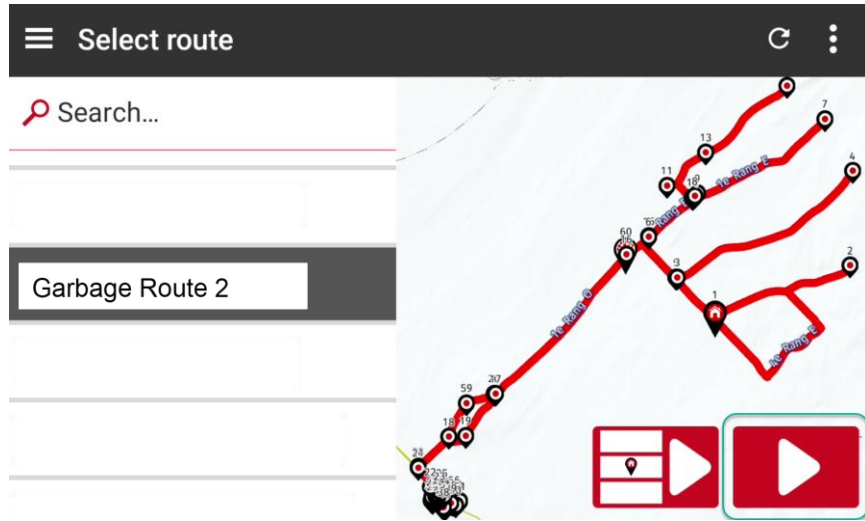

<span style="border: 1px solid green; border-radius: 50%; padding: 2px 5px; display: inline-block; text-align: center; width: 20px; height: 20px; line-height: 20px;">2</span>	GARBAGE ROUTE 1	Route created in Focus and downloaded to the tablet for this vehicle.
<span style="border: 1px solid green; border-radius: 50%; padding: 2px 5px; display: inline-block; text-align: center; width: 20px; height: 20px; line-height: 20px;">3</span>	GARBAGE ROUTE 2	Route created in Focus and downloaded to the tablet for this vehicle.
<span style="border: 1px solid green; border-radius: 50%; padding: 2px 5px; display: inline-block; text-align: center; width: 20px; height: 20px; line-height: 20px;">4</span>	REFRESH	If any changes have been made from the dispatch, use the refresh button to receive the latest route.

Note: There is no limit on the number of routes per vehicle.



All that's left to do is press the  to start navigation.

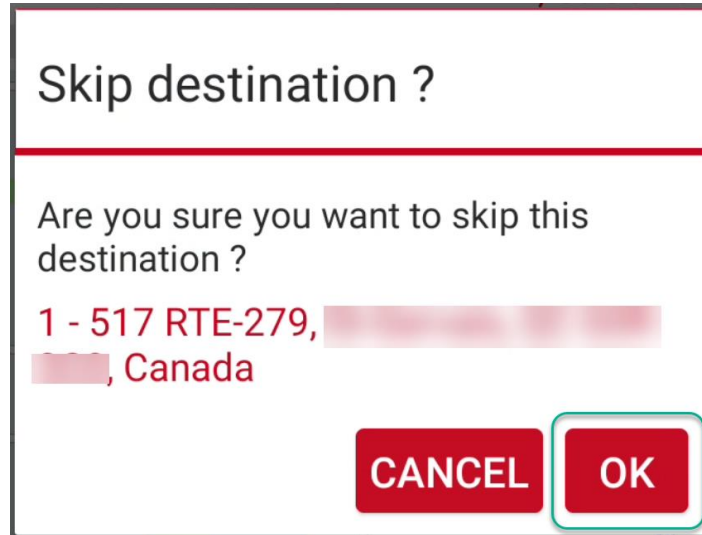




You can press the STOP button to stop navigation and return to the route selection menu.

If you skip a destination or leave the predefined route, the system will give you four options:

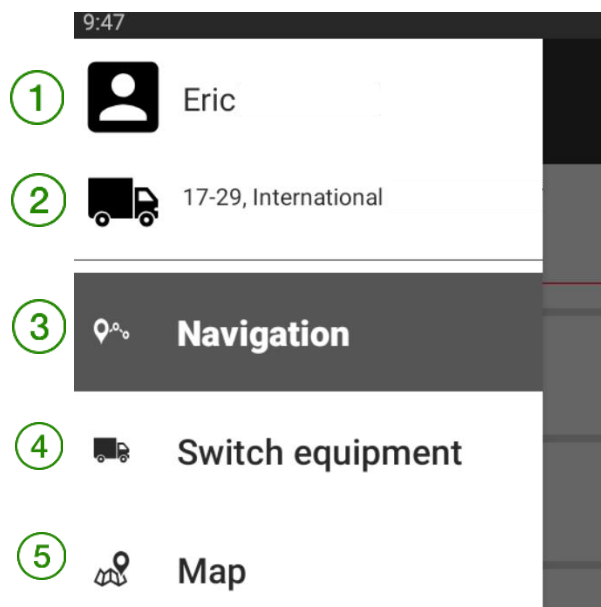
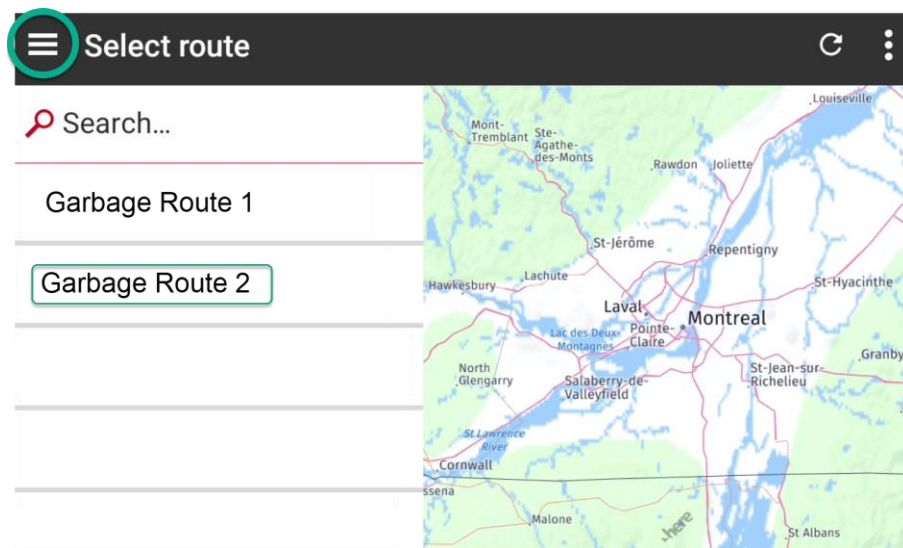
## Select the pick-up point

- ③ 2 4804 King Street
- ④ 3 4882 King Street



ID	SECTION/COLONNE	DESCRIPTION
①	LAST POINT	Go to last point.
②	EXIT POINT	Return to route exit point.
③	NEXT POINT	Go to next point on route.
④	SKIP NEXT POINT	Skip the next point and move on to the next.

Select the option that suits you best. By selecting the 3 horizontal lines in the top left-hand corner, you'll be presented with a number of options.

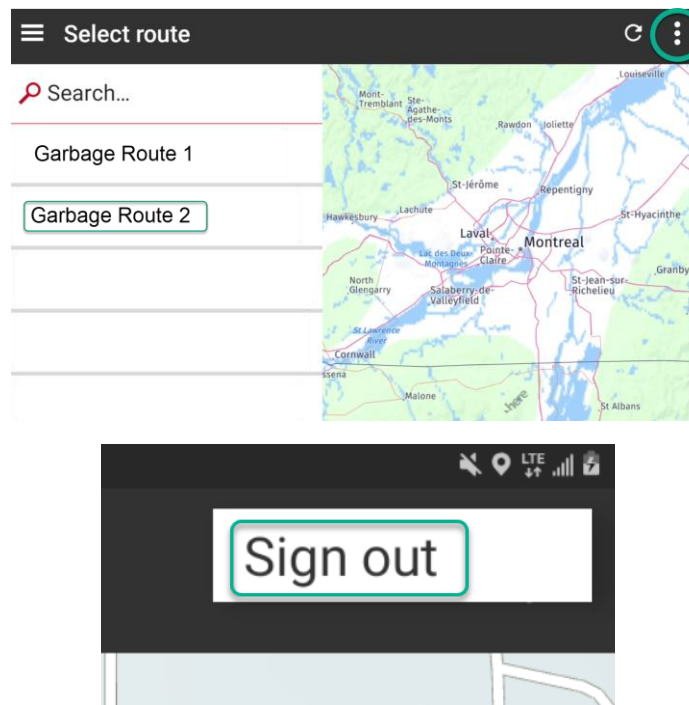




ID	SECTION/COLONNE	DESCRIPTION
①	USER NAME	Name of the user currently logged on to the tablet.
②	ACTIVE VEHICLE	Name and number of currently selected vehicle.
③	NAVIGATION	Main menu displaying map and routes.
④	CHANGE EQUIPEMENT	If necessary, you can change equipment/vehicle.
⑤	MAP	This option allows you to download provincial or state maps to the tablet's memory.

For all options, simply follow the instructions displayed.

When you've finished your route or working day, click on the three dots in the top right-hand corner and choose "Log off".



Shut down the tablet when disconnected.
